We were meant to stop at Holt but another train needed to go past us but there was an un-exploded bomb on the top of a bridge. We couldn't wait for the bomb squad team to get there...so we had to go under the bomb, when we did we had to put our hands on our heads which were on the table. When we got there an air raid started. What were we going to do? Well there was a nearby bunker (safe house) when the bombing was over; our hearts were pumping like mad. We had rations for lunch, we learned about the different types of aeroplane and before we came back we looked inside a train carriage cottage and did a few of the chores there. For the final few minutes we raised the flag of the Union jack.


