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Firstly a very BIG THANK YOU for all the support you have been giving your children to learn their spellings. This has really helped to reinforce their knowledge.

We surveyed a selection of parents (28 in total) to find out what you thought of the Spelling resources we have sent home during this term. This is what you told us:

- overwhelmingly parents/carers had found the spelling pack useful (26)
- \* the majority of parents/carers considered that the spelling resources had helped their child to learn spellings (23)
- · 19 parents/carers had noticed an improvement in their child's spelling ability
- \* we discovered that parents/carers had found the letter and the spelling flash card sheet the most helpful resources

#### YEAR 5 CURIOSITY CAFÉ EVALUATION

We wanted to find out the impact that Curiosity Cafes have had on pupils and parents at FJS, so we asked Year 5 parents/carers for their opinions. Year 5 pupils and their families have now been experiencing Curiosity Cafes since they entered the school in Year 3.

This is what we found out from the 34 parents/carers who responded:

- that Curiosity Cafes have made FJS more welcoming to parents/carers and families.
- that the majority of children ask their parents/carers/families to come to curiosity cafes and that adults were sure that the children enjoyed them coming in.
- parents/carers considered that experiencing their child's classroom has been useful in supporting learning at home.
- - parents/carers believed that coming to Curiosity Cafes had helped them feel more informed and more confident in supporting learning at home.
- the majority of parents/carers/families find it difficult to attend Curiosity Cafes and some cannot attend at all.

We asked whether we could make it easier for parents/carers to attend. Some respondents suggested we could run some sessions after school – we will think about how we might best achieve this.

Finally we asked what parents/carers would like the focus of following Curiosity Cafes to be: Writing = 14 Reading = 8 Maths = 9 ICT = 11 Topic = 12
