Progress and Attainment Data – July 2014

The table below shows the **Attainment** data for 2014.

This records FJS attainment, those children achieving Level 4 and Level 5 in national SATs tests. As you will see pupil's attainment at FJS is broadly in line with national attainment levels and in some areas higher. This data helps us to identify areas we need to focus on to improve teaching so that attainment is improved.

The table also shows **Progress** across the school in 2014. This is measured from our testing of pupils in Years 3,4 and 5. As you will see the data demonstrates that pupils are making good progress in all areas at FJS and Reading and Writing is higher than the national average.

PARENT FORUM

The first ever FJS Parent Forum was held on Tuesday 13th January in Café Scrumptious. Although only 3 parents were present we had a really useful meeting and discussed the following topics:

- Parents were concerned about the departure of Ms Cook and were uncertain of the school Management structure.
- We discussed communication between home and class teachers, particularly in view of improving the Homework Diary. Parents noted that sometimes these were not signed by teachers and that some of the pages – particularly 'progress towards targets' were not used.
- We discussed that sometimes children were given information but did not convey this accurately – and how this could be improved.
- Parents felt that the Texting system was really good for letting them know what is going on.
- We were able to report that the Website is currently under review and our intention is to make it more 'parent/carer friendly'.

What we have done in response to some of the issues raised:

We will use the Newsletter to inform parents of changes in personnel – introducing new staff and explaining the Management structure.

We will redesign and update the Homework Diary to make it more useful to parents/teachers and pupils and we will ensure that Homework Diaries are looked at and signed by teachers weekly.

We will work with children on ensuring that they have understood information and instructions which they need to convey home.

Those parents present thought it was important to have another meeting so that more parents could attend and have their say. So we have arranged a further PARENTS FORUM for:
